

Perhaps I should be looking for more writers to give me more time to make better reviews while still keeping the pace of publishing up, writing 300 reviews in a year in two languages isn't easy to do on your own.

I think that with that workload the quality can sometimes suffer and I believe I am often a bit too much on the positive side in my reviews even though I sometimes get critique for being too hard on many bands. But looking at aver-

an average of four points mainly thanks to more than half of the reviews being four points. This is not really something I think about when I write other than trying to weight the albums of a genre against one another to figure out if it is good, bad or just indifferent. Because if all the albums in a genre are really good, then the good have to be considered average otherwise a review system would be quite pointless - kind of like reading reviews on most Internet sites, a site or a reviewer just giving positive reviews cannot be seen as credible.
